Headquarters of anti-Fascist parties at Rome. Committee set up at Naples only a local affair.

At a meeting held on Sept. 28th the Socialist and Communist Parties came to an agreement for common action, especially with regard to armed resistance and the Unions. However, this agreement has not produced results of any great consequence, because local branches have not gotten together and in some places the Socialists predominate and in others the Communists.

Stories that the partisans had occupied parts of Trieste are absolutely without foundation. Few partisans $\frac{did}{dt}$ penetrated region between Postumia and Fiume.

There is a maquis group in the Val d'Aosta.

The group around Lecco has been attacked, but has not dispersed.
