Dear Mr. Dulles:

I am against a representative of the Italian Socialist Party taking part in the American or British radio propagande from Worth Affica. If any Party member skould do so, it would be entirely in his own name and on his own responsibility.

A careful control made in the last few weeks of the Allied broadcasts in Italian shows the complete absence of all facts and episodes il ustrating the resistance of the Italian people to Pascism. If this is in in a definite line of policy, permit me to express my stupefaction. If on the other hand it is simply due to technical difficulties, please let us do something about it.

Although the letter contains references to the treacheries of the lattle individual, it ends up with an appeal that he listen to the people's pleas for peace. This letter has made an extremely bad impression in antifascist circles, and we are inclined to believe it spurious.

The CGDL (General Confederation of Labour) has asked us for 30.000 lire for technical installations, plus 8.000 lire monthly for normal expenses. The Italian Socialist Party now needs 15.000 lire monthly. The funds in hend are sufficient for several months yet. The Partito d'Azlone sends its thanks and says it has no needs at present. Among its members there are also some very rich people. We are unaware of any organisation under the leadership of Emilio.
